

Making and answering calls

Answering calls

1. When your keystation rings, lift your handset. You are immediately connected to the call.

Making external calls

Depending upon the dialling mode programmed for your keystation, you may be able to dial your call before lifting your handset.

- 1. Pick up the handset.
- 2. Dial (or the exchange line access code).
- 3. Dial the external telephone number.

Making internal calls

- 1. Pick up the handset.
- 2. Dial the internal number.

Note: Station numbers and the exchange line access code are supplied by your System Administrator.

Making or answering a second call

The Economy Keystation allows you to have two calls active at the same time.

You can switch between calls using Hold

To answer a second call while on another call

1. Press Hold to put the first call on hold.

The second call automatically comes onto the line.

To hold a call and make a second call

- 1. Press [Hold to put the first call on hold.
- 2. Dial the telephone number for the second call.

To return to the first call

Press Hold again to return to the first call on hold.
 The second call is automatically put on hold.

Hold

Holding Calls

- 1. Press Hold
- 2. Press [Hold again to return to the call on hold.

Note: If you have difficulty selecting a line on your Economy Keystation, ask your System Administrator to check your keystation's programming. You must have an exchange line or line pool as your prime line, and your keystation must be assigned to use that exchange line or line pool.

When you are on a call and the second line rings at your keystation, if you press [Hold ______], your current call will be placed on hold and the second call is automatically answered.

Programming the memory key

About memory keys



The memory key can store a telephone number or feature code to give you one touch dialling or feature activation. You can change the memory key by programming it with a new number or feature code.

Memory key

Remember: Press Feature * 0 to check a memory or line key.

Programming memory keys

External Autodial

- 1. If you are on a call or an open line with dial tone, press [Hold or [RIS]].
- 2. Press Feature * 1.
- 3. Dial the external number.
- 4. Press Hold to store the number.
- 5. Label your new key.

Internal Autodial

- 1. If you are on a call or an open line with dial tone, press Hold or Ris
- 2. Press Feature * 2.
- 3. Dial the station number.
- 4. Label your new key.

Features

- 1. If you are on a call or an open line with dial tone, press [Hold or [RIs]].
- 2. Press Feature * 3.
- 3. Press Feature and the feature code.
- 4. Label your new key.

Erasing memory keys

- 1. If you are on a call or an open line with dial tone, press [Hold or RIS].
- 2. Press Feature * 1.
- 3. Press Hold to erase the key.
